



ITEC Level 2 Award in Apply Skin Tanning Techniques QAN 600/6546/1 Learner Guidance Notes

General Advice

1. Requirements for Undertaking this Qualification

ITEC recommend that you should have achieved a level of education equivalent to five GCSEs at grade A*-C or Level 1 Diploma in Beauty Therapy prior to commencing the ITEC Level 2 Award in Apply Skin Tanning Techniques; however, your Centre may make exemptions for adult returners with experience of the workplace

2. Structure of the Qualification, Guided Learning (GL)

The ITEC Level 2 Award in Apply Skin Tanning Techniques is comprised of 1 mandatory unit with a total of 30 hours of Guided Learning (GL) in order to achieve the full qualification. However, you will also be required to complete further study and generate evidence of your learning in your own time. This is known as Total Qualification Time (TQT), please see Table 1 below:-

3. Grading of the Qualification

All assessment tasks required for each unit of the qualification (detailed in Table 1 above) must be completed and awarded a Pass mark before the full qualification can be certificated

The qualification is graded Pass

Your results and Certificates will be sent to your Centre by ITEC. Therefore, you will need to collect your results and Certificates from your Centre

4. Assessment of the Qualification

The ITEC Level 2 Award in Apply Skin Tanning Techniques will be internally and externally assessed using a variety of assessment methods as set out in Table 1 above

Once you have completed all the specified assessments for the qualification and your Lecturer has awarded a Pass mark for all the evidence you have submitted, the ITEC External Verifier will verify a sample of all the evidence you have completed during your training to ensure it meets the ITEC standard

Internal Task Assessment

- a. The internal task assessment forms part of the internal assessment and should be assessed by the Lecturer using the appropriate internal task assessment forms
- b. The internal task form for each unit should be completed by the Lecturer and placed with the relevant documentation for the ITEC External Verifier
- c. Unit 912 will be internally practically assessed
- d. The internal assessment(s) will be conducted by the Centre's Lecturer/Internal Verifier(s) and will be sampled by the ITEC External Verifier

Assignments

- a. Unit 912 is assessed by the completion of an assignment
- b. Your assignment forms part of your internal assessment and should be assessed throughout your training by your Lecturer using the ITEC Guidance Forms
- c. The criteria for the assignments are detailed on the Assignment Guidance and Assessment Form
- d. Your Lecturer will complete the ITEC Assessment Forms and ensure they are ready for verification by the ITEC External Verifier
- e. The internal assessment will be conducted by the Centre's Lecturer/Internal Verifier(s) and will be sampled by the ITEC External Verifier

5. Resources

Your Centre must provide a suitable environment for teaching the ITEC Level 2 Award in Apply Skin Tanning Techniques as well as all equipment both fixed and free standing to complete all aspects of the qualification. You may need to supply some consumables and/or towels in order to complete your training

6. Opportunities for Progression

Once you have achieved the ITEC Level 2 Award in Apply Skin Tanning Techniques you may progress on to other ITEC or equivalent qualifications at Level 2 or 3, for example:

- Level 2 Diploma for Beauty Specialists
- Level 2 Diploma in Hair, Photographic and Media Make-up
- Level 2 Certificate in Photographic Make-up
- Level 3 Certificate in Airbrush Make-up
- Level 3 Certificate in Camouflage Make-up
- Level 3 Diploma in Advanced Beauty Therapy
- Level 3 Diploma in Fashion and Specialised Make-up
