### **Aims and Objectives**

The main aim of the ITEC Level 3 Certificate in Epilation is to enable Learners to gain the necessary practical and theoretical skills in order to provide Epilation Treatments to the general public and to gain employment in the Make-up Industry. This qualification is suitable for Learners aged 16 and over and is designed to provide occupational competence at Level 3. It also provides a sound platform into further training at Level 3 and 4

### **Content**

This qualification is for Learners who want to work within the Beauty Therapy Industry. The qualification consists of 4 mandatory units with a total of 176 hours of Guided Learning (GL) to achieve the full qualification

The main skills the you will perform are:

- Epilation – to include carrying out skin and hair analysis and using products, tools, equipment and techniques to suit the client's treatment needs
- Working in the beauty related industries

You will also develop knowledge about related health and safety and client care and communication which is essential to work and be successful in the Beauty Industry

This qualification also provides:

- The related knowledge and understanding required to perform the beauty treatments listed above as well as understanding the structures that the Learner will be working over, in particular recognition of skin and hair types, skin diseases and reasons that may affect whether a client should or should not be treated
- Opportunities for Learners to focus on the development of their wider skills in a beauty therapy setting, such as communicating with clients, working with others and problem solving
- Opportunities for Learners to develop a range of skills, techniques, personal qualities and attitudes essential for successful performance in employment as an Electrologist

### **Why Choose the ITEC Level 3 Certificate in Epilation?**

1. This Qualification combines the full range of skills and knowledge for the Learner seeking employment or self-employment as an Epilation Artist at Level 3. There are other ITEC Diplomas containing Epilation at Level 3, however, they also contain the skills for performing other Facial and Body Treatments. This qualification enables the Learner to Specialise in Epilation only, ready for employment in the Industry
2. This Qualification is listed in the Ofqual Register of Qualifications
3. This Qualification contains all the skills and knowledge required for employability at Level 3
4. Learners may progress on to the ITEC Level 3 Diploma in Spa Treatments, the ITEC Level 4 Diploma in Advanced Skincare, the ITEC Level 4 Diploma in Spa and Salon Management, the

Level 4 Certificate in Laser and Light Treatment for Skin Rejuvenation or the ITEC Level 4 Certificate in Laser and Light Treatment for Hair Removal

5. This qualification does not form part of an Apprenticeship
6. This qualification is recognised by all relevant professional bodies within the Beauty Therapy Industry for membership and insurance purposes at Level 3
