Learner Guidance Notes

General Advice

1. Requirements for Undertaking this Qualification

It is recommended that Learners have achieved a basic level of education prior to commencing the ITEC Entry Level 3 Award in an Introduction to the Hair and Beauty Sector

2. Structure of the Qualification, Guided Learning (GL)

The ITEC Entry Level 3 Award in an Introduction to the Hair and Beauty Sector is comprised of 2 mandatory units; Learners must also select 1 optional unit at or above the level of the qualification. A total of 70 hours of Guided Learning (GL) are required to achieve the full qualification. However, you will also be required to complete further study and generate evidence of your learning in your own time. This is known as Total Qualification Time (TQT), please see Table 1 and 2 below:-

3. Grading of the Qualification

All assessment tasks required for each unit of the qualification (detailed in Table 1 and 2 above) must be completed and awarded a Pass mark before the complete qualification can be certificated

The overall qualification is graded - Pass

Your results and Certificates will be sent to your Centre by ITEC. Therefore, you will need to collect your results and Certificates from your Centre

4. Assessment of the Qualification

The ITEC Entry Level 3 Award in an Introduction to the Hair and Beauty Sector will be internally assessed using a variety of assessment methods as set out in Table 1 and 2 above

The projects and tasks will be internally assessed by your Centre's Lecturer/Internal Verifier(s) and verified by an ITEC External Verifier, who will verify a sample all the evidence you have completed during your training to ensure it meets the ITEC standard

Internal Task Assessment

- a. The internal practical assessment forms part of the internal assessment and should be assessed by the Lecturer using the appropriate marking criteria and internal task assessment forms
- b. The internal task assessment form for each unit should be completed by the Lecturer and placed with the relevant documentation for the ITEC External Examiner
- c. Units 301, 302, 303, 305, 306, 307, 308, 309, 310, 311 and 312 will be assessed by internal tasks
- d. The internal assessment(s) will be conducted by your Centre's Lecturer/Internal Verifier(s) and will be sampled by the ITEC External Verifier

Projects

- a. Units 300, and 304 are assessed by the completion of a project
- b. Your projects form part of your internal assessment and should be assessed throughout your training by your Lecturer using the ITEC Guidance Forms
- c. The criteria for the assignments are detailed on the Assignment Guidance and Assessment Form
- d. Your Lecturer will complete the ITEC Assessment Forms and ensure they are ready for verification by the ITEC External Verifier
- e. The internal assessment(s) will be conducted by your Centre's Lecturer/Internal Verifier(s) and will be sampled by the ITEC External Verifier

5. Resources

Your Centre must provide a suitable environment for teaching the ITEC Entry Level 3 Award in an Introduction to the Hair and Beauty Sector as well as all equipment both fixed and free standing to complete all aspects of the qualification. You may need to supply some consumables and/or towels in order to complete your training

6. Opportunities for Progression

Once you have achieved the ITEC Entry Level 3 Award in an Introduction to the Hair and Beauty Sector, you may progress on to other ITEC or equivalent qualifications at Level 1 and 2 for example:

- Level 1 Diploma in Beauty Therapy
- Level 2 Diploma for Beauty Therapists
- Level 2 Diploma in Beauty Therapy Treatments
- Level 2 Diploma in Hair, Photographic and Media Make-up

- Level 2 Apprenticeship in Beauty – General
- Level 2 Apprenticeship in Beauty – Make-up
- Level 2 Apprenticeship in Nail Services
- Level 1 Diploma in Hairdressing
- Level 2 Diploma in Hairdressing
- Level 2 Diploma in Hairdressing and Barbering
- Level 2 Diploma in Women’s Hairdressing
- Level 2 Apprenticeship in Barbering
- Level 2 Apprenticeship in Hairdressing
