



ITEC Entry Level 3 Award in an Introduction to the Hair and Beauty Sector QAN 500/6099/5 Lecturer Guidance Notes

General Advice

1. Requirements for Undertaking this Qualification

It is recommended that Learners have achieved a basic level of education prior to commencing the ITEC Entry Level 3 Award in an Introduction to the Hair and Beauty Sector

A scheme of work must be approved by ITEC prior to the commencement of the course for all units

2. Structure of the Qualification, Guided Learning (GL), Total Qualification Time (TQT) and Credit Value

The ITEC Entry Level 3 Award in an Introduction to the Hair and Beauty Sector is comprised of 2 mandatory units; Learners must also select 1 optional unit at or above the level of the qualification. A total of 70 hours of Guided Learning (GL) are required to achieve the full qualification

Guided Learning (GL) – 70

Guided Learning is 'the activity of a Learner in being taught or instructed by – or otherwise participating in education or training under the immediate guidance or supervision of – a Lecturer, Supervisor, Tutor or other appropriate provider of education or training'. This includes 'the activity of being assessed if the assessment takes place under the immediate guidance or supervision of a Lecturer, Supervisor, Tutor or other appropriate provider of education or training'

Total Qualification Time (TQT) – 76

Total Qualification Time is 'the number of notional hours which represents an estimate of the total amount of time that could reasonably be expected to be required in order for a Learner to achieve and demonstrate the achievement of the level of attainment necessary for the award of the qualification'

Total Credit Value - 8

The total Credit Value for the qualification is equal to one tenth of the Total Qualification Time rounded to the nearest whole number

3. Delivery of the Qualification

Lecturers should aim to deliver the theory and practical of each unit simultaneously, i.e., both theory and practical of each unit should be taught together to ensure the underpinning knowledge is being delivered at the same time as the practical skills. This will help to ensure that Learners understand the structures they are working on as a result of combining delivery with the practical application of treatments

4. Assessment and Grading of the Qualification

Learner's results and Certificates will be issued by ITEC directly to the Centre. Learners should be notified that they need to collect their results and Certificates from their Centre

This qualification will be internally assessed by the Centre's Lecturer/Internal Verifier(s) using the assessment of skills as set out in Table 1 and 2 below and will be sampled by the ITEC External Verifier

5. Grading of the Qualification

All assessment tasks required for each unit of the qualification (detailed in Table 1 and 2 above) must be completed and awarded a Pass mark before the complete qualification can be certificated

The overall qualification is graded - Pass

6. Assessment of the Qualification

The ITEC Entry Level 3 Award in an Introduction to the Hair and Beauty Sector will be internally assessed using a variety of assessment methods as set out in Table 1 and 2 above

Internal Task Assessment

- a. The internal task assessments form part of the internal assessment and should be assessed by the Lecturer using the appropriate marking criteria and internal practical assessment forms
- b. The internal task form for each unit should be completed by the Lecturer and placed with the relevant documentation for the ITEC External Examiner
- c. Units 301, 302, 303, 305, 306, 307, 308, 309, 311 and 312 will be assessed by internal tasks
- d. The internal assessment(s) will be conducted by the Centre's Lecturer/Internal Verifier(s) and will be sampled by the ITEC External Verifier

Projects

- a. The projects form part of the internal assessment and should be assessed throughout the training by the Lecturer using the appropriate guidance forms
- b. Projects must be completed in the Learner's own time. The Lecturer must monitor the quality of the documentation throughout the Learner's training to ensure that they meet the ITEC criteria. The criteria is detailed on the Project Guidance and Assessment Forms
- c. The Assessment Forms for each unit should be completed and placed with the relevant documentation for verification by the ITEC External Examiner
- d. Units 300 and 304 will be assessed by a project

7. Resources

The organisation delivering the qualification must provide a suitable environment for teaching the ITEC Entry Level 3 Award in an Introduction to the Hair and Beauty Sector as well as all equipment both fixed and free standing to complete all aspects of the qualification. Learners need to be made aware of the amount of consumables/towels they will be required to provide

8. Registration

Enrolments for the qualification and all units should be sent to ITEC together on the ITEC Enrolment Form – paper based or online

9. Opportunities for Progression

Once Learners have achieved the ITEC Entry Level 3 Award in an Introduction to the Hair and Beauty Sector, they may progress on to other ITEC or equivalent qualifications at Level 1 and 2, for example:

- Level 2 Diploma for Beauty Therapists
- Level 2 Diploma in Beauty Therapy Treatments
- Level 2 Diploma in Hair, Photographic and Media Make-up
- Level 2 Apprenticeship in Beauty – General
- Level 2 Apprenticeship in Beauty – Make-up
- Level 2 Apprenticeship in Nail Services
- Level 1 Diploma in Hairdressing
- Level 2 Diploma in Hairdressing
- Level 2 Diploma in Hairdressing and Barbering
- Level 2 Diploma in Women's Hairdressing

- Level 2 Apprenticeship in Barbering
- Level 2 Apprenticeship in Hairdressing
