

## ITEC Unit 665 Blow Dry Hair ITEC

<p><b>What this unit is about:</b></p>	<p>This standard is about carrying out basic blow drying techniques using tools and products following the instructions of the stylist.</p> <p>To carry out this standard, you will need to maintain health, safety and hygiene throughout your work. You will also need to maintain a professional personal appearance and demonstrate good communication skills.</p> <p>The main outcomes of this standard are:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. maintain effective and safe methods of working when blow drying hair</li> <li>2. blow dry hair</li> </ol>
<p><b>Evidence Requirements:</b></p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Simulation is not allowed for any performance evidence within this unit</li> <li>2. You must practically demonstrate in your everyday work that you have met the standard for blow drying hair</li> <li>3. Your Assessor will observe these aspects of your performance on <b>at least 3 occasions</b> each for a different client</li> <li>4. From the range, you must show that you have: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- used <b>both</b> types of tools</li> <li>- worked on <b>both</b> the hair lengths</li> <li>- used <b>all</b> the blow drying techniques</li> </ul> </li> <li>5. If the range <b>requirement</b> has not been fully covered by these observations you may be able to provide additional <b>observed</b> evidence</li> </ol>
<p><b>What you must do: (Performance Criteria)</b></p>	<p><b>Maintain Effective and Safe Methods of Working when Blow Drying Hair</b></p> <p>P1 maintain your responsibilities for health and safety throughout the service</p> <p>P2 prepare your client to meet salon's requirements</p> <p>P3 protect your client's clothing throughout the service</p> <p>P4 position your client to meet the needs of the service without causing them discomfort</p> <p>P5 ensure your own posture and position whilst working minimises fatigue and the risk of injury</p> <p>P6 keep your work area clean and tidy throughout the service</p> <p>P7 use working methods that:</p> <p>P7.1 minimise the wastage of products</p> <p>P7.2 minimise the risk of damage to <b>tools</b> and equipment</p> <p>P7.3 minimise the risk of cross-infection</p> <p>P7.4 make effective use of your working time</p> <p>P7.5 ensure the use of clean resources</p> <p>P7.6 minimise the risk of harm or injury to yourself and others</p> <p>P8 ensure your personal hygiene, protection and appearance meets accepted industry and organisational requirements</p> <p>P9 follow stylist's instructions throughout the service</p> <p>P10 follow workplace and suppliers' or manufacturers' instructions for the safe use of equipment, materials and products</p>

	<p><b>Blow Dry Hair</b></p> <p>P11 confirm <b>blow drying</b> instructions with your stylist prior to starting the service</p> <p>P12 apply products if required, following your stylist's instructions</p> <p>P13 control your <b>tools</b> and equipment to minimise the risk of damage to the <b>hair</b> and client discomfort</p> <p>P14 check your client is comfortable during the <b>blow drying</b> process</p> <p>P15 use your <b>tools</b> and equipment effectively to achieve the required result</p> <p>P16 control your client's <b>hair</b> during the <b>blow drying</b> process</p> <p>P17 take sections of <b>hair</b> which suit the size of styling <b>tools</b></p> <p>P18 maintain an even tension throughout the <b>blow drying</b> process</p> <p>P19 keep the <b>hair</b> damp throughout the <b>blow drying</b> process</p> <p>P20 ensure the finished result meets with your stylist's instructions</p>
