

ITEC Unit 664 Assist with Hair Colouring and Lightening Services

<p>What this unit is about:</p>	<p>This unit is about the basic skills of removing colouring and lightening products. The work will be carried out under the direction of the stylist.</p> <p>To carry out this unit, you will need to maintain health, safety and hygiene throughout your work. You will also need to maintain a professional personal appearance and demonstrate good communication skills</p> <p>The main outcomes of this unit are:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. maintain effective and safe methods of working when assisting with colouring and lightening services 2. remove colouring and lightening products
<p>Evidence Requirements:</p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Simulation is not allowed for any performance evidence within this unit 2. You must practically demonstrate in your everyday work that you have met the standard for assisting with hair colouring and lightening services 3. Your Assessor will observe these aspects of your performance on at least 2 occasions, 1 of which will include the removal of colouring and lightening materials 4. You must show that you have used 3 out of the 4 products in the range 5. If the range requirement has not been fully covered by these observations you may be able to provide additional observed evidence
<p>What you must do: (Performance Criteria)</p>	<p>Maintain Effective and Safe Methods of Working when Assisting with Colouring and Lightening Services</p> <p>P1 maintain your responsibilities for health and safety throughout the service</p> <p>P2 prepare your client to meet salon's requirements</p> <p>P3 protect your client's clothing throughout the service</p> <p>P4 wear personal protective equipment when removing products</p> <p>P5 position your client to meet the needs of the service without causing them discomfort</p> <p>P6 ensure your own posture and position whilst working minimises fatigue and the risk of injury</p> <p>P7 keep your work area clean and tidy throughout the service</p> <p>P8 use working methods that:</p> <p>P8.1 minimise the wastage of products</p> <p>P8.2 minimise the risk of cross-infection</p> <p>P8.3 make effective use of your working time</p> <p>P8.4 ensure the use of clean resources</p> <p>P8.5 minimise the risk of harm or injury to yourself and clients</p> <p>P9 ensure your personal hygiene protection and appearance meets accepted industry and organisational requirements</p> <p>P10 follow workplace and suppliers' or manufacturers' instructions for the safe use of equipment, materials and products</p> <p>P11 follow stylist's instructions throughout the service</p>

	<p>P12 dispose of waste materials</p> <p>P13 replenish low levels of resources, when required, to minimise disruption to your own work and to clients</p>
	<p>Remove Colouring and Lightening Products</p> <p>P14 remove products and materials in a way which minimises the risk of damage to the hair and follow stylist's instructions</p> <p>P15 ensure your working methods minimise the risk of colour and lightener being spread to the client's skin, clothes and surrounding areas</p> <p>P16 leave the hair and scalp clean and free from products and excess moisture</p> <p>P17 refer any problems to the relevant person for action</p> <p>P18 leave the hair tangle-free without causing damage to hair or scalp</p> <p>P19 ensure the removal of products is to the satisfaction of the stylist and the client</p>
