

MARKING CRITERIA
ITEC LEVEL 2
Unit 811 – Design And Apply Mendhi Skin Decoration

APPEARANCE – 5 MARKS (0.5 marks each)

The learner demonstrated:

1. Clean, ironed professional uniform
2. Clean, neat hair - tied back/up if long and off the collar and face
3. Clean, short nails, well manicured with no varnish and clean hands
4. Clean sensible full, flat shoes worn with socks or tights
5. Tights were an appropriate colour for the uniform, if wearing a skirt
6. No jewellery - with the exception of a wedding band and 1 pair of small stud earrings (religious jewellery must be taped)
7. No body or breath odour
8. No chewing gum or sucking sweets
9. No visible underskirts/underwear
10. Trousers cropped no higher than calf/trousers not trailing on the floor and skirts to the knee

CLIENT CARE – 5 MARKS (1 mark each)

The learner:

1. Greeted and introduced self to client
2. Positioned self and client correctly throughout treatment
3. Explained the treatment procedures to the client
4. Ensured client's comfort/modesty, assisted them throughout treatment
5. Communicated and behaved in a professional manner throughout

HYGIENE AND STERILISATION – 10 MARKS (2 marks each)

The learner:

1. Followed health and safety working practices throughout
2. Used products, tools and equipment in a hygienic manner
3. Disposed of cotton wool, tissues, paper roll and general waste hygienically and appropriately
4. Maintained client hygiene throughout treatment. Ensured footwear for clients was stowed under the couch and that the client did not walk around with bare feet
5. Managed treatment and work environment throughout

PREPARATION OF TREATMENT AREA AND CLIENT – 5 MARKS (1 mark each)

The learner:

1. Carried out a consultation and checked for contraindications
2. Assessed the area to be treated and checked if a skin sensitivity test has been carried out
3. Discussed clients requirements and possible contra-actions to treatment
4. Selected products, tools and equipment to suit client treatment needs
5. Prepared work environment, self and client for treatment

MENDHI DESIGN – 30 MARKS (6 marks each)

The learner:

1. Sectioned the hands for different patterns
2. Applied designs with accuracy, speed and appropriate flow
3. Used the appropriate freehand and stencilling techniques
4. Applied appropriate decorations (such as decorative stones and jewellery)
5. Used the correct cone shaped applicator

APPLICATION OF MENDHI DECORATION – 30 MARKS (6 marks each)

The learner:

1. Selected and mixed the appropriate Mendhi paste
2. Applied the chosen Mendhi design to the clients satisfaction
3. Applied Mendhi treatment products evenly
4. Described the Mendhi ingredients, its effect and possible contra-actions
5. Completed the treatment in a commercially acceptable time

AFTER/HOME CARE ADVICE - 15 MARKS (3 marks each)

The learner:

1. Documented the client response to treatment and client feedback
2. Informed the client of short term effects of treatment and recommended and provided immediate aftercare
3. Reviewed the treatment plan, noting any treatment adaptations required
4. Recommended and recorded home care and product advice
5. Recommended and recorded follow on appointment(s)
