

Marking Criteria for ITEC Level 3
Unit 834 – Fashion and Specialised Make-Up

APPEARANCE – 5 MARKS (0.5 marks each)

The candidate demonstrated:

1. Clean, ironed professional uniform
2. Clean, neat hair, tied back/up if long and off the collar and face
3. Short, clean, well manicured nails with no varnish and clean hands
4. Clean, sensible full flat shoes, socks should be worn
5. Tights were an appropriate colour for the uniform, if wearing a skirt
6. No jewellery- with the exception of a wedding band and 1 pair of small stud earrings (religious jewellery must be taped)
7. No body or breath odour
8. No chewing gum or sucking sweets
9. No visible underskirts/underwear
10. Skirts to the knee. Trousers cropped no higher than calf/ trousers not trailing on the floor

CLIENT CARE – 5 MARKS (1 mark each)

The candidate:

1. Greeted and introduced self to client.
2. Assisted client off the couch.
3. Explained the treatment procedure to the client.
4. Ensured the client's comfort/modesty throughout.
5. Maintained a positive and professional approach to client/colleagues throughout

HYGIENE AND STERILISATION – 10 MARKS (2 marks each)

The candidate:

1. Wiped equipment over with appropriate sanitiser before and after use.
2. Sanitised hands before, during and after treatment as appropriate.
3. Replaced lids on products and used spatulas to remove cream.
4. Disposed of cotton wool, tissues, paper roll and general waste hygienically and appropriately.
5. Used salon/clinic sterilising equipment/cabinets appropriately and sanitised, used and stored small equipment appropriately.

MAKE UP TECHNIQUES– 20 MARKS (2 marks each)

The candidate:

1. Prepared the work area for make-up application.
2. Checked for contraindications and allergies.
3. Protected client's clothing/costume adequately
4. Selected make-up according to the character/production
5. Applied selected make-up in the appropriate sequence
6. Applied selected make-up using appropriate techniques
7. Ensured make-up application is hygienic at all times
8. Blended selected make-up using appropriate techniques
9. Used make-up materials economically
10. Ensured that the finished make-up meets the design specification

CHOICE OF COSTUME – 10 MARKS (2marks each)

The candidate:

1. Selected costume according to the character/production
2. Used imagination in the choice of materials to achieve the design
3. Finished hair/wigs appropriately to achieve the required design
4. Made maximum use of all available resources
5. Ensured that the end result meets the design specification

TIMING – 10 MARKS

The candidate:

1. Worked to time limits acceptable to industry

ORIGINALITY/DESIGN – 10 MARKS (2 marks each)

The candidate:

1. Used imagination in the choice of character/theme
2. Ensured that relevant research is made available
3. Ensured that designs meet the production requirements
4. Ensured that designs are realistic in terms of materials available
5. Ensured that charts and notes are clear and detailed

PHOTOGRAPHIC – 15 MARKS (1 mark each)

The candidate:

1. Prepared the work area for make-up application
2. Checked for contraindications and allergies
3. Prepared and protected the skin according to the skin type
4. Selected appropriate make-up to achieve the desired outcome
5. Applied selected make-up in the appropriate sequence
6. Applied selected make-up using appropriate techniques
7. Blended selected make-up using appropriate techniques
8. Used make-up materials economically
9. Ensured make-up application is hygienic at all times
10. Ensured that the client's clothing/costume is adequately protected
11. Demonstrated how to highlight and contour accordingly
12. Demonstrated how to conceal or correct imperfections
13. Considered the effects of lighting when applying make-up
14. Maintained make-up using appropriate techniques
15. Ensured that the finished make-up meets the design specifications on camera

CHARACTER – 15 MARKS (1 mark each)

The candidate:

1. Prepared the work area for make-up application
2. Checked for contraindications and allergies
3. Prepared and protected the skin according to the skin type
4. Selected appropriate make-up to achieve the agreed outcome
5. Applied selected make-up in the appropriate sequence
6. Applied selected make-up using appropriate techniques
7. Blended selected make-up using appropriate techniques
8. Used make-up materials economically
9. Ensured make-up application is hygienic at all times
10. Ensured that the client's clothing/costume is adequately protected.
11. Demonstrated application of specialised products
12. Demonstrated artistic interpretation.
13. Considered the effects of lighting when applying make-up
14. Ensured the effect of the make-up is maintained
15. Ensured that the finished make-up meets the design specifications on camera
