

Marking Criteria

ITEC Level 3 Unit 836 – Design and Apply Face and Body Art

APPEARANCE – 5 MARKS (1 mark each)

The Candidate demonstrated:

1. Clean, ironed professional uniform
2. Clean, neat hair, tied back/up if long and off the collar and face
3. Short, clean, well manicured nails with no varnish and clean hands
4. Clean, sensible full flat shoes, socks should be worn
5. Tights were an appropriate colour for the uniform, if wearing a skirt
6. No jewellery- with the exception of a wedding band and 1 pair of small stud earrings (religious jewellery must be taped)
7. No body or breath odour
8. No chewing gum or sucking sweets
9. No visible undershirts/underwear
10. Skirts to the knee. Trousers cropped no higher than calf/ trousers not trailing on the floor

CLIENT CARE – 5 MARKS (1 mark each)

The Candidate:

1. Greeted and introduced self to client.
2. Assisted client off the couch.
3. Explained the treatment procedure to the client.
4. Ensured the client's comfort/modesty throughout.
5. Maintained a positive and professional approach to client/colleagues throughout.

HYGIENE AND STERILISATION –10 MARKS (1 mark each)

The Candidate:

1. Wiped equipment over with appropriate sanitiser before and after use.
2. Sanitised hands before, during and after treatment as appropriate.
3. Replaced lids on products and used spatulas to remove cream.
4. Disposed of cotton wool, tissues, paper roll and general waste hygienically and appropriately.
5. Used salon/clinic sterilising equipment/cabinets appropriately and sanitised, used and stored small equipment appropriately.

SELECTION OF FACE AND BODY ART DESIGNS – 20 MARKS (4 marks each)

The Candidate:

1. Carried out a consultation and checked for contraindications
2. Assessed the area to be treated
3. Discussed clients requirements and possible contra-actions to treatment
4. Agreed the art design plan and theme with the client
5. Showed originality

APPLICATION OF PAINTING TECHNIQUE AND FACE AND BODY ART – 30 MARKS (6 marks each)

The Candidate:

1. Selected the correct size brushes for the area
2. Ensured the paint was of a workable consistency
3. Selected colours which were appropriate for the theme
4. Ensured that the design application follows the agreed design plan
5. Covered the area correctly for the theme

FINISHED RESULT – 25 MARKS (5 marks each)

The Candidate:

1. Ensured the finished result produced the desired overall effect
2. Ensured the overall effect is to the client's satisfaction
3. Gave immediate after care advice
4. Gave appropriate home care advice
5. Completed the treatment in a commercially acceptable time
