

Marking Criteria

ITEC Level 3 Unit 869 - Apply Prosthetic Pieces and Bald Caps

APPEARANCE – 10 MARKS (1 mark each)

The Candidate demonstrated:

1. Clean, ironed professional uniform
2. Clean, neat hair - tied back/up if long and off the collar and face
3. Clean, short nails, well manicured with no varnish and clean hands
4. Clean sensible full, flat shoes worn with socks or tights
5. Tights were an appropriate colour for the uniform, if wearing a skirt
6. No jewellery - with the exception of a wedding band and 1 pair of small stud earrings (religious jewellery must be taped)
7. No body or breath odour
8. No chewing gum or sucking sweets
9. No visible undershirts/underwear
10. Trousers cropped no higher than calf/trousers not trailing on the floor and skirts to the knee

CLIENT CARE – 5 MARKS (1 mark each)

The Candidate:

1. Greeted and introduced self to client
2. Positioned self and client correctly throughout treatment
3. Explained the treatment procedures to the client
4. Ensured client's comfort/modesty, assisting them throughout treatment
5. Communicated and behaved in a professional manner throughout

HYGIENE AND STERILISATION – 5 MARKS (1 mark each)

The Candidate:

1. Wiped equipment over with appropriate sanitiser before and after use
2. Sanitised hands before, during and after treatment as appropriate
3. Replaced lids on products and used spatulas to remove cream
4. Disposed of cotton wool, tissues, paper roll and general waste hygienically and appropriately
5. Used salon/clinic sterilising equipment/cabinets appropriately and sanitised, used and stored small equipment appropriately

PREPARATION OF TOOLS AND EQUIPMENT – 10 MARKS (5 marks each)

The Candidate:

1. Prepared the work area for make-up/prosthetic piece application and protected client's clothing/costume adequately
2. Selected make-up/prosthetic equipment according to the character/design/type of prosthetic

CLIENT PREPARATION AND PROSTHETIC APPLICATION – 20 MARKS (2 marks each)

The Candidate:

1. Checked for contraindications and allergies
2. Selected appropriate prosthetic adhesive to achieve the agreed outcome
3. Cleansed and prepared the skin according to skin type
4. Selected and applied prosthetic in the correct sequence
5. Selected and applied prosthetic using appropriate application techniques
6. Demonstrated application of specialised product
7. Considered the effects of lighting when applying prosthetics
8. Ensured the effect of the prosthetic is maintained
9. Used prosthetic materials economically
10. Ensured that the finished prosthetic application meets the design specification

BALD CAP T-PIN REMOVAL – 2 MARKS (1 mark each)**The Candidate:**

1. Removed T-Pin from head block
2. Removed bald cap from head block

COLOUR CORRECTION AND MAKE-UP APPLICATION - 20 MARKS (2 marks each)**The Candidate:**

1. Selected appropriate make-up to achieve the agreed outcome
2. Ensured make-up application is hygienic at all times
3. Applied prosthetic make-up using appropriate colour correction techniques
4. Applied make-up in the correct sequence
5. Blended selected make-up using appropriate techniques
6. Demonstrated application of specialised products
7. Considered the effects of lighting when applying make-up
8. Ensured the effect of the make-up is maintained
9. Used make-up materials economically
10. Ensured that the finished make-up meets the design specification

REMOVAL AND CLEANING - 8 MARKS (4 marks each)**The Candidate:**

1. Removed/Cleaned prosthetic pieces using appropriate product
2. Cleansed and protected skin according to skin type

FINISHED RESULT – 20 MARKS (1 = 15marks and 2 = 5marks)**The Candidate:**

1. Ensured the overall effect and finished result met the design specification and performer's satisfaction
2. Ensured that appropriate home care advice was given to the performer
