

# Marking Criteria

## iUBT420 – Intimate waxing for female clients

Once all aspects of the mandatory units have been completed, learners will be expected to complete an internal practical assessment. This will be undertaken by an internal assessor using the internal assessment forms. These must be handed to the external examiner on the day of the final external practical examination.

- Practical examination sequence – approximately 45 minutes
- Learners are to perform either a full Brazilian or Hollywood treatment to be agreed with the examiner
- It is the responsibility of the college to ensure that learners supply sufficient clients with suitable hair growth in the area
- The external examiner must be notified prior to the start of the examination if the learners have clients who do not have sufficient hair to wax. Learners may be withdrawn from this unit where the client has insufficient hair growth to permit full demonstration of the required techniques
- Learners must not share clients
- Oral questions may be asked at any time during the examination
- Consultation forms must be filled in by each learner and made available for the external examiner to check. These should be reviewed and completed at the end of the treatment and will be taken away by the external examiner
- Learners will be expected to demonstrate excellent hygiene and client care throughout as well as competence in their relevant skills
- The external examiner may reduce the treatment timings, as the examination is a demonstration of the Learner's professionalism and their accomplished technique
- Approximate time allocated for changeover of practical examination groups – 15 minutes

Learners must achieve a minimum of 3 marks for appearance and 3 marks for client care in order to pass the practical examination

Learners must be able to demonstrate the following: -

### **Appearance – 5 marks (0.5 marks each)**

1. Clean, ironed professional uniform
2. Clean, neat hair, tied back/up if long and off the collar and face
3. Short, clean, well-manicured nails with no varnish and clean hands
4. Clean, sensible, fully flat shoes, worn with socks
5. If wearing a skirt, ensure tights are an appropriate colour for the uniform
6. No jewellery – with the exception of a wedding band and 1 pair of small stud earrings (religious jewellery must be taped)
7. No body or breath odour
8. No chewing gum or sucking sweets
9. No visible underskirts/underwear
10. Skirts to the knee, trousers cropped no higher than calf/trousers not trailing on the floor

**Client care – 5 marks (1 mark each)**

1. Greeted and introduced self to client
2. Assisted client throughout as appropriate
3. Explained and agreed the treatment procedure with the client
4. Ensured the client's comfort/modesty throughout
5. Maintained a positive and professional approach to client throughout

**Hygiene and sterilisation – 10 marks (2 marks each)**

1. Wiped equipment over with appropriate sanitiser before and after use
2. Sanitised hands before and after treatment and wore gloves throughout the procedure, changing them as/when appropriate
3. Replaced lids on products and used spatulas to remove cream
4. Disposed of cotton wool, tissues, paper roll and general and contaminated waste hygienically and appropriately
5. Used salon/clinic sterilising equipment/cabinets appropriately and sanitised, used and stored small equipment appropriately

**Application of hot wax – 20 marks (2 marks each)**

1. Carried out consultation and checked for previous patch test results and contra-indications
2. Prepared the area appropriately for the waxing treatment
3. Tested the temperature of the wax prior to the treatment
4. Applied the wax without any discomfort to the client
5. Applied the wax in the correct direction using the correct technique
6. Applied the wax hygienically
7. Applied the wax economically
8. Applied the wax appropriately for the area being treated
9. Applied the wax efficiently and without dripping onto surrounding areas
10. Performed the waxing application in a commercially acceptable time

**Removal of hot wax and finished result – 50 marks (see below)**

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| 1. Removed wax efficiently and cleanly   | (6 marks) |
| 2. Removed wax with minimum discomfort to the client and without causing bruising or adverse reactions | (6 marks) |
| 3. Supported the area correctly during the removal   | (6 marks) |
| 4. Removed wax in the correct direction  | (6 marks) |
| 5. Removed wax in a logical pattern  | (6 marks) |
| 6. Disposed of removed wax hygienically  | (2 marks) |
| 7. Ensured that the area is free from hair after removal   | (2 marks) |
| 8. Ensured that the area is free from wax after removal  | (2 marks) |
| 9. Tweezed out any stray hairs where appropriate   | (2 marks) |
| 10. Soothed the skin with the appropriate medium   | (2 marks) |
| 11. Applied aftercare lotion hygienically  | (2 marks) |

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| 12. Learner did not have wax on themselves                    | (2 marks) |
| 13. No wax left the couch or surrounding area                 | (2 marks) |
| 14. Avoided skin on skin contact after removal                | (2 marks) |
| 15. Completed the treatment in a commercially acceptable time | (2 marks) |

**Aftercare – 10 marks (2 marks each)**

1. Made recommendations for immediate aftercare and appropriate home care advice
2. Advised on avoiding activities that may cause contra-action
3. Recommended another appointment and frequency
4. Advised the client of the incidence of ingrowing hairs
5. Completed the client record card appropriately

**Sample oral questions**

1. Describe the client's skin type?
2. What type of hair grows in the underarm area?
3. How would you respond if a client had a skin tag in the area to be waxed?
4. What is the specific aftercare advice for this treatment?
5. Describe the contra-indications to this treatment?
6. What aftercare advice would you give to the client to prevent ingrowing hairs?
7. What other types of hair removal would be suitable for this client?
