
Marking Criteria

iUBT371 – Asian bridal make-up

Once all aspects of the mandatory units have been completed, learners will be expected to complete an internal practical assessment. This will be undertaken by an internal assessor using the internal assessment forms. These must be handed to the external examiner on the day of the final external practical examination.

Practical examination sequence – approximately 60 minutes

- Consultation forms may be partially filled out prior to the practical examination
- Clients must be wearing full day make-up
- Cleanse
- Tone
- Moisturise
- Asian bridal make-up suitable for the client
- Remove head band/hair protection prior to examiner's final check
- Oral questions may be asked at any time during the examination
- Consultation forms must be filled in by each learner and made available for the external examiner to check. These should be reviewed and completed at the end of the treatment and will be taken away by the external examiner
- Learners will be expected to demonstrate excellent hygiene and client care throughout as well as competence in their relevant skills
- The examiner may reduce the treatment timings, as the examination is a demonstration of the learner's professionalism and their accomplished technique
- Approximate time allocated for changeover of practical examination groups – 15 minutes

Learners must achieve a minimum of 3 marks for appearance and 3 marks for client care in order to pass the practical examination.

Learners must be able to demonstrate the following:

Appearance – 5 marks (0.5 marks each)

1. Clean, ironed professional uniform
2. Clean, neat hair, tied back/up if long and off the collar and face
3. Short, clean, well-manicured nails with no varnish and clean hands
4. Clean sensible, full flat shoes worn with socks or tights
5. If wearing a skirt, tights must be an appropriate colour for the uniform
6. No jewellery with the exception of a wedding band and 1 pair of small stud earrings (religious jewellery must be taped)
7. No body or breath odour
8. No chewing gum or sucking sweets
9. Underskirts/underwear should not be visible
10. Skirts to the knee. Trousers cropped no higher than calf/trousers not trailing on the floor

Client care – 5 marks (1 mark each)

1. Greeted and introduced self to client
2. Positioned self and client correctly throughout treatment
3. Explained the treatment procedures to the client
4. Ensured client's comfort/modesty, assisting them throughout treatment
5. Communicated and behaved in a professional manner throughout

Hygiene and sterilisation – 10 marks (2 marks each)

1. Followed health and safety working practices throughout
2. Used products, tools and equipment in a hygienic manner
3. Disposed of cotton wool, tissues, paper roll and general waste hygienically and appropriately
4. Ensured footwear for clients was stowed under the couch/chair and that the client did not walk around with bare feet
5. Managed the treatment and work environment throughout

Preparation of treatment area and client – 5 marks (1 mark each)

1. Carried out a consultation and checked for contra-indications
2. Discussed client's requirements and possible contra-actions to treatment
3. Discussed and agreed the proposed treatment plan
4. Selected products, tools and equipment to suit client treatment needs
5. Prepared work environment, self and client for treatment

Cleanse - 5 marks (1 mark each)

1. Selected the correct cleansing products for the client's skin type/condition
2. Performed the cleanse routine, twice, in the correct sequence
3. Used suitable cleansing techniques to remove make-up
4. Toned and blotted the skin after cleansing
5. Completed the treatment in a commercially acceptable time and left the skin clean and free from make-up residue

Skin analysis – 5 marks (1 mark each)

1. Positioned and used a magnifying lamp correctly to assess the client's skin
2. Recognised and recorded the client's skin type/characteristics
3. Recognised and recorded any skin imperfections/lesions and checked for contra-indications
4. Recommended treatments suitable for client skin type/characteristics
5. Recommended and recorded the treatment plan and products for home care

Make-up application**Pre-base – 2 marks**

1. Selected and applied a pre-base suitable for client's skin type and condition

Foundation/concealer/colour correction – 10 marks (2 marks each)

1. Selected and applied colour corrective products suitable for client's needs, using appropriate tools and techniques
2. Selected and applied concealer suitable for client's needs, using appropriate tools and techniques
3. Selected and applied foundation suitable for client's skin colour and skin type, using appropriate tools and techniques
4. Ensured foundation is blended fully and evenly
5. Applied make-up products using appropriate pressure and support

Eye make-up – 15 marks (3 marks each)

1. Selected products and colours suitable for client's needs
2. Applied eye shadow hygienically and blended suitably using appropriate tools and techniques
3. Applied eyeliner hygienically using appropriate tools and techniques
4. Applied mascara hygienically using appropriate tools and techniques
5. Applied eye make-up products using appropriate pressure and support

Powder/blusher – 10 marks (2 marks each)

1. Selected a powder suitable for client's needs
2. Applied powder hygienically using appropriate techniques
3. Selected blusher suitable for the client's needs
4. Applied blusher hygienically using appropriate techniques
5. Ensured blusher was symmetrical and applied to the appropriate area for the client's face shape

Lip make-up – 10 marks (2 marks each)

1. Selected a lip liner suitable for client's needs
2. Ensured the lip liner is sharpened/sanitised prior to application
3. Applied the lip liner using appropriate pressure and support
4. Selected a lipstick suitable for client's needs
5. Applied lipstick hygienically using appropriate pressure and support

Overall effect – 18 marks (6 marks each)

1. Make-up is balanced and evenly applied
2. Make-up application is suitable for the client and the make-up specification including jewellery
3. Completed the Asian bridal make-up in a commercially acceptable time and a commercially acceptable finish

Sample Oral questions

1. How do you maintain the hygiene of make-up sponges?
2. How would you sanitise the make-up palette?
3. How would you apply shader to minimise a wide nose?
4. How would you apply eyeshadow to correct deep-set eyes?
5. How would you apply a cream foundation?
