Learner Guidance Notes

General Advice

1. Requirements for Undertaking this Qualification

ITEC recommend that you should have achieved a level of education equivalent to five GCSEs at grade A*-C prior to commencing the ITEC Level 2 NVQ Level 2 Diploma in Hairdressing; however your Centre may make exemptions for adult returners with experience of the workplace.

2. Structure of the Qualification, Guided Learning (GL)

The ITEC Level 2 Diploma in Hairdressing is comprised of 7 mandatory units with a total of 561-595 hours of Guided Learning (GL) and a selection of optional units covering a minimum of 77 hours of Guided Learning (GL) must also be completed in order to achieve the full qualification. However, you will also be required to complete further study and generate evidence of your learning in your own time. This is known as Total Qualification Time (TQT), please see Table 1 and 2 below:

3. Grading of the Qualification

All assessment tasks required for each unit of the qualification (detailed in Table 1 and 2 above) must be completed and awarded a Pass mark before the full qualification can be certificated

The overall qualification is graded as a Pass

Your results and Certificates will be sent to your Centre by ITEC. Therefore you will need to collect your results and Certificates from your Centre

4. Assessment of the Qualification

The ITEC Level 2 Diploma in Hairdressing will be internally and externally assessed using a variety of assessment methods as set out in Table 1 and 2 above

The overall qualification is graded as a Pass

Multiple-choice Tests

Each question is formatted in the same way:

- 1 stem (the question)
- 1 key (the correct answer)
- 3 distractors (incorrect answers)
- You must indicate the answer you believe is correct by placing a mark in the appropriate box on your answer sheet

Multiple-choice tests are used for units 676, 677, 679, 684, 685, 680 and 686 - online testing of all relevant units is also available

Portfolio of Evidence

Portfolio of evidence forms part of the internal assessment of your qualification and should be assessed throughout your training by your Assessor using the appropriate ITEC guidance forms. You are required to provide evidence of services that you have performed on clients during your training, under the supervision of your Assessor who will monitor the quality of your client services in order to ensure that they meet the ITEC criteria

- The criteria are detailed on the Record of Assessment Pages. They are graded Pass or Refer
- You will need to complete a Client Consultation Form as evidence that you performed the required number of services during your training (see Table 1 and 2) as they form part of your internal assessment for the qualification. They can be stored in your ITEC E-portfolio

5. Resources

Your Centre must provide a suitable environment for teaching the ITEC Level 2 Diploma in Hairdressing, as well as all equipment both fixed and free standing to complete all aspects of the qualification. You may need to supply some consumables, hairdressing tools and/or towels in order to complete your training

6. Opportunities for Progression

Once you have achieved the ITEC Level 2 Diploma in Hairdressing you may progress on to other ITEC or equivalent qualifications at Level 2 or 3, for example:

- Level 3 Apprenticeship in Hairdressing
- Level 3 Diploma in Hairdressing
- Level 2 Certificate in Barbering
- Level 3 Certificate in Barbering
- Level 3 Certificate in African Type Hair
