



VTCT Skills (ITEC) Level 2 NVQ Diploma in Nail Services QAN 501/0191/2 Specification

Aims and Objectives

The main aim of the VTCT Skills (ITEC) Level 2 NVQ Diploma in Nail Services is to enable Learners to gain the necessary practical skills and knowledge in order to provide Nail Services to the general public and to gain employment in the Nail Industry. The qualification is suitable for Learners aged 16 and over and is designed to provide occupational competence at Level 2. It also provides a sound platform into further learning at Levels 2 and 3

Content

This qualification is for Learners who want to work within the Nail Industry. The qualification consists of 8 units, all of which are mandatory; 329 hours of guided learning are required to achieve the full qualification

The main skills the Learner will perform are:

- Carrying out consultations – to include contraindications and planning and preparing for the services
- Pedicure treatments – to include care of the feet and nails, massage of the feet and lower leg, application of polish and aftercare advice
- Manicure treatments – to include care of the hands and nails, massage of the hand and lower arm, application of polish and aftercare advice
- Application of nail art – to include designing a plan and application of nail art using sequenced nail art techniques to achieve the required design
- Nail enhancements – to include application and maintenance and creating a natural finish
- Salon reception duties – to include maintaining the reception area, booking appointments and handling payments

The Learner will also develop knowledge about related health and safety, any relevant legislation, the Code of Practice for Nail Services, how to promote additional services and products to customers and client care and communication which is essential to work and be successful in the Beauty Industry

The qualification also provides:

- The related knowledge and understanding required to perform the nail skills outlined above; in particular the anatomy and physiology of the hand and lower arm and the feet and lower leg and common diseases and disorders that may affect when a client should or should not receive treatment
- Opportunities for Learners to focus on the development of their wider skills in a nail setting, such as communicating with clients, working with others and problem solving
- Opportunities for Learners to develop a range of skills, techniques, personal qualities and attitudes essential for successful performance in employment as a Nail Technician

Why Choose the VTCT Skills (ITEC) Level 2 NVQ Diploma in Nail Services?

1. This Qualification combines the full range of skills and knowledge for the Learner seeking employment or self-employment as a Nail Technician at Level 2. This qualification is the only VTCT Skills (ITEC) Level 2 NVQ Diploma in Nail Services that meets the current National Occupational Standards
2. This Qualification is listed in the Ofqual Register of Qualifications
3. This Qualification contains all the skills and knowledge required for employability at Level 2
4. Learners may progress on to the VTCT Skills (ITEC) Level 2 Diploma in Beauty Therapy General, the VTCT Skills (ITEC) Level 2 Diploma in Beauty Therapy Make-up, the VTCT Skills (ITEC) Level 3 NVQ Diploma in Nail Services, the VTCT Skills (ITEC) Level 3 NVQ Diploma in Therapy General, the VTCT Skills (ITEC) Level 3 NVQ Diploma in Beauty Therapy Massage, the VTCT Skills (ITEC) Level 3 Diploma in Beauty Therapy Make-up, or the VTCT Skills (ITEC) Level 3 Diploma in Spa Therapy
5. This qualification also forms part of the Level 2 Apprenticeship in Nail Services. This qualification can be studied outside the apprenticeship by Learners who are unable to gain an apprenticeship position or are not eligible for an apprenticeship due to prior qualifications, but wish to be occupationally competent and employed as a Nail Technician
6. This qualification leads to employability and is the employer's preference with support from Beauty Therapy salons across the UK. It remains the qualification of choice amongst Further Education Colleges as local employers require it for their employees
7. This qualification is recognised by all relevant professional bodies within the Beauty Therapy Industry for membership and insurance purposes at Level 2

Guided Learning (GL)

Guided Learning is the 'activity of a Learner in being taught or instructed by – or otherwise participating in education or training under the immediate guidance or supervision of – a Lecturer, Supervisor, Tutor or other appropriate provider of education or training'. This includes 'the activity of being assessed if the assessment takes place under the immediate guidance or supervision of a Lecturer, Supervisor, Tutor or other appropriate provider of education or training'

Total Qualification Time (TQT)

Total Qualification Time is the number of notional hours which represents an estimate of the total amount of time that could reasonably be expected to be required in order for a Learner to achieve and demonstrate the achievement of the level of attainment necessary for the award of the qualification

Total Credit Value

The total Credit Value for the qualification is equal to one tenth of the Total Qualification Time rounded to the nearest whole number.

This qualification will be internally and externally assessed using a range of assessment methods as set out in the table below:-

Grading of the Qualification

All assessment tasks required for each mandatory unit of the qualification (detailed in table 1 of the specification) must be completed and awarded a Pass mark before the complete qualification can be certificated

The overall qualification is graded as a Pass

Controlled Assessment

All theory tests must be conducted in a controlled environment and follow the procedures defined by ITEC [here](#). The theory tests will be set and marked by ITEC

The internal assessment will be conducted by the Centre's Assessor/Internal Verifier(s) and will be sampled by the ITEC External Verifier; however, the Centre is responsible for ensuring the assessment can operate seamlessly by organising the process as defined by ITEC in the Lecturer/Assessor Guidance Notes [here](#). Recommended Prior Learning

It is recommended that Learners should have achieved a level of education equivalent to five GCSEs at grade A*-C or prior to commencing the VTCT Skills (ITEC) Level 2 NVQ Diploma in Nail Services; however, exemptions may be made for adult returners with experience of the workplace.

Opportunities for Progression

Once Learners have achieved the VTCT Skills (ITEC) Level 2 NVQ Diploma in Nail Services they may progress on to other VTCT Skills (ITEC) or equivalent qualifications at Level 2 or 3, for example:

- Level 2 NVQ Diploma in Beauty Therapy General
- Level 2 NVQ Diploma in Beauty Therapy Make-up
- Level 3 NVQ Diploma in Nail Services
- Level 3 NVQ Diploma in Beauty Therapy Massage
- Level 3 NVQ Diploma in Beauty Therapy Make-up
- Level 3 NVQ Diploma in Spa Therapy
